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Scope: Androscoggin County is seeking bids to replace the pavement on our walkways in front of the courthouse and to pave the adjacent parking lot. Below is a spec of what I believe should be a minimum thickness/type of materials. Contractors bidding will need to specify in detail their materials and course of action. The parking lot has Two (2) storm drains that will need to be replaced with new updated storm basins with steel grates.

If the budget permits we would like to continue to pave up to the jail between the garage and the YMCA. Please provide an alternate price option for area C.

**\*A scheduled walk-thru is required for bidding May 11 @ 1 p.m.**

Spec:

1. The walkways and beneath the stairs have asphalt that will need to be removed including the cement patches. The shape and size will match the existing. The gravel beneath the asphalt is believed to be only 2 inches thick and may need to be increased/changed and pitched away from the building. We are requesting that the total thickness of asphalt be a min of 2 inches thick.
2. The Parking lot between the courthouse and the YMCA (**area A and B**) will be paved with a minimum of 4 inches of pavement. This includes removing the old pavement in section **A**. Pitch will be designed to accommodate the proper drainage to the storm drains.
3. A minimum of a 12x12 concrete storm basin with a steel grid will replace the drains (2) currently in the parking lot.

Start Date: As soon as possible


Contractor responsibilities:
